

POINT ISABEL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT
ORDER OF VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE ELECTION

A special election is hereby ordered to be held on November 7, 2023 pursuant to Texas Tax Code Sections 26.05 and 26.08 to approve the 2023-2024 ad valorem tax rate for Point Isabel ISD because the adopted rate exceeds the PIISD Voter-Approval Tax Rate ("VATR").

At the Election, the ballot proposition shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the District using the language required by statute:

"Ratifying the ad valorem tax rate of \$0.825 in Point Isabel ISD for the current year, a rate that will result in an increase of 8.74% percent in maintenance and operations tax revenue for the district for the current year as compared to the preceding year, which is an additional \$3,681,201."

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted beginning on October 23 and ending on November 3, 2023.
