CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, August 14, 2020, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the District Clerk's Office, one (1) employee from Public Works Precinct 3, and eight (8) employees from the Sheriff's Office have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe.
