THIRD AMENDED EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDER INCLUDING MANDATORY FACIAL COVERINGS, CURFEW, LIMITATIONS ON GATHERINGS, SHELTER-IN-PLACE, AND BEACH ACCESS CLOSURES

Effective immediately, Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., with the consent of the County Commissioners' Court and pursuant to the Texas Disaster Act of 1975 has ordered the Third Amended Emergency Management Order Including Mandatory Facial Coverings, Curfew, Limitations on Gatherings, Shelter-in-Place, and Beach Access Closures issued and signed on June 29, 2020. This Order is issued as a continued Public Health Emergency measure to reduce and combat the transmission rate of COVID-19 in Cameron County.

All residents and visitors to and from Cameron County are to comply with the provisions in the Order and a failure to do so constitutes as an imminent threat to public health and may be subject to a fine. Cameron County will proceed with the established Order which will expire on September 7, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. unless otherwise extended, modified, or terminated early.
