## **CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19**

Today, October 9, 2020, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the District Attorney's Office, and one (1) employee from the Copy Center have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. "The COVID-19 case count in Cameron County is stable, but we are not out of the risk of transmission. We are averaging 60 cases a day for the past three weeks now and would like to report much less, the closest possible to zero. I continue to urge everyone to please continue to do what's right for the protection of your loved ones and those around you. The COVID-19 case count among our departments are decreasing, but I continue to ask that all County employees continue to utilize health and sanitation protocols when out in public to prevent the spread of COVID-19 both at work and at home," stated Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr.
