The 44 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 40,551 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 83 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 37,592.

Cameron County Public Health does not have any reports of COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents for today. The current total of deaths is 1,634.

Cameron County continues the vaccination efforts within our communities. As of today, 44.63% of the population 16 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 65.04% has received at least one dose. In addition, 68.08% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 81.72% has received at least one dose.
