CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEE TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, July 23, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Auditor's Office has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. Constituents are asked to continue to conduct business online by going through the County's website at https://www.cameron.county.us/.

"Over the last several days, we have seen COVID-19 cases on the rise in our County and are in part attributed to the 4th of July congregations.
