The 227 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 43,970 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 35 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 40,528.

Cameron County Public Health does not have any reports of COVID-19 related deaths. of Cameron County residents for today. The current total numbers of COVID-19 deaths is 1,705.

Cameron County continues the vaccination efforts within our communities. As of today, 68.10% of the population 12 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 79.97% has received at least one dose. In addition, 81.80% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 89.85% has received at least one dose.
