CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, September 24, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Sheriff's Office has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. Constituents are asked to continue to conduct business online by going through the County's website at https://www.cameron.county.us/.

"We continue with COVID-19 vaccination clinic plans for our County and have both Pfizer and Moderna vaccines available. Please contact Cameron County Public Health hotline at (956) 247-3650 for more information and vaccination clinic updates. As per the Texas Department of State Health Services Dashboard, 92% of our County's population 12 years of age and above, and 93% of individuals 65 years of age and above have been vaccinated with at least one dose. Please continue to protect yourself and each other. To all county employees, please continue to follow all health and sanitation protocols when out in public to prevent the spread of COVID-19 both at home and at work," stated Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr.
