**CAMERON COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION RECOMMENDED  
PRECAUTIONS FOR TROPICAL STORM NICHOLAS**

Cameron County Parks and Recreation Department is currently monitoring Tropical Storm Nicholas which is forecasted to make landfall along the lower Texas coast early to mid-day on Monday. We currently ask that all guests anchor and secure their RVs and store any items properly, such as umbrellas, canopies, chairs, beach toys, portable tables, BBQ pits, etc. These items can become unsafe and hazardous during high winds. Any updates will be posted on the Parks and Recreation Facebook page, the Cameron County website, and the Parks and Recreation website as we continue to monitor the conditions of Tropical Storm Nicholas.
