CAMERON COUNTY AIRPORT RECEIVES \$1.3 MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) AVIATION DIVISION

Cameron County is pleased to announce that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Aviation Division awarded a combined grand total of \$1.3 Million for capital improvement projects for the Port Isabel – Cameron County Airport to assist with preservation efforts and to meet standard state and federal regulations. The Port Isabel – Cameron County Airport was one of seven airports awarded funding by TxDOT to assist with the development and establishment of airports throughout the entire State. Awarded funds to Cameron County will assist with the replacement and upgrade of its over 5-mile wildlife fencing.

The continued development and upkeep of our County Airport is essential and this fencing upgrade that is scheduled to break ground within the next month is crucial for the ongoing protection of South Texas’s wildlife from aviation activity.
