**CAMERON COUNTY TO HOST MASS DRIVE-THRU MODERNA
VACCINE BOOSTER CLINIC ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2021**

Cameron County Public Health and the Office of Emergency Management will host a mass drive-thru Moderna Vaccine Booster Clinic tomorrow, Saturday, October 30, 2021, at the Los Fresnos Volunteer Fire Department from 7:00 a.m. until supplies last.

Eligible individuals are those that meet the following criteria:

- 6 months after completing the Moderna or Pfizer inoculation, or 2 months after receiving the Johnson & Johnson vaccine; and
- 65 years of age and above; or
- 18 years of age and above with underlying medical conditions, live or work in high-risk settings, or those that live in long-term care facilities.

All individuals are asked to please arrive with your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card, remain in your vehicle upon arrival, and complete the consent and registration forms to be provided on site.
