The 146 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 52,353 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 45 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 48,012.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of three (3) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. Of these reported deaths, 2 out of 3 were not vaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,910.
