The 133 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 52,735 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 64 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 48,413.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of five (5) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. Of these deaths, 4 were unvaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,944.

In addition, 85.91% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 93.82% has received at least one dose.
