The 33 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 53,347 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 39 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 49,090.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of one (1) additional COVID-19 related death of a Cameron County resident. The reported death was unvaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,972.
