The 13 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 53,491 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 55 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 49,289.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of three (3) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. All reported deaths were unvaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,980.
