The 24 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 53,538 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 70 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 49,414.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of four (4) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. All reported deaths were unvaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,985.

Cameron County continues the vaccination efforts within our communities. On November 4<sup>th</sup>, the vaccination numbers were updated to include the population 5 years of age and older. As of today, 72.76% of the population 5 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 84.11% has received at least one dose. In addition, 87.28% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 95.48% has received at least one dose.
