The 41 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 53,686 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 248 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 50,505.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of three (3) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. The deaths reported today were unvaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,990.

As of today, 73.22% of the population 5 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 85.62% has received at least one dose. In addition, 87.58% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 95.99% has received at least one dose.
