**CAMERON COUNTY JUDGE'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY  
MANAGEMENT & FIRE MARSHAL SERVICE UPDATE REGARDING  
UPCOMING WINTER WEATHER CONDITIONS**

The US National Weather Service of Brownsville / Rio Grande Valley is informing that a strong cold front is expected to arrive between the hours of midnight tonight and the morning hours of tomorrow, Thursday, February 3, 2022. In Cameron County, cold temperatures, and/or strong winds and rain are expected through Saturday, February 5, 2022.

Please prepare for the upcoming winter weather conditions, and protect your pets and plants as expected conditions will produce dangerous weather for all. For warming center assistance, please contact your local municipality for availability, location details, or for related assistance.

Should a power outage occur, please remember to turn off your heating source to ensure a smooth service restoration. Once service has been restored, heating can safely be turned on. All individuals are asked to follow winter safety precautions at all times and never use a generator, charcoal grill, gasoline or propane heater, or camp stove indoors to keep warm. Never use a motor vehicle for personal warming within an enclosed garage as breathing in carbon monoxide at high levels can be fatal.

The Cameron County Judge's Office of Emergency Management & Fire Marshal Service will continue to monitor weather conditions and work diligently across all levels of communication. Visit your local municipality and power company's social media pages to remain informed.
