**UPDATE REGARDING WINTER WEATHER CONDITIONS:
FREEZE WARNING IN EFFECT FOR CAMERON COUNTY**

A Freeze Warning is in effect for Cameron County with forecasted temperatures to drop into the upper 20s to lower 30s between the hours of midnight tonight and tomorrow morning. Freeze Warnings, Hard Freeze Warnings, and Wind Chill Advisories have been issued for South Texas counties by the US National Weather Service in Brownsville, Texas.

Please protect your people, pets, pipes, and plants as dangerous winter weather conditions are projected to continue through next week. Individuals are asked to please follow all winter safety precautions, including dressing in layers, and limit exposure to the elements. Remember, should a power outage occur, please turn off the heating source to ensure a smooth service restoration. Once the service has been fully restored, the heating source can safely be turned on.

Warming centers and shelters remain available throughout Cameron County. Please contact your local municipality for on-the-hour details, or the warming center or shelter directly for related assistance and information.

The Cameron County Judge's Office of Emergency Management & Fire Marshal Service is closely monitoring the ongoing winter weather conditions and remains in communication with the National Weather Service, the State of Texas, area municipalities, and power companies.
