**CAMERON COUNTY IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE STREET
IMPROVEMENTS AT ISLA BLANCA COUNTY PARK**

Cameron County is pleased to announce road improvements to thirteen streets at Isla Blanca County Park. Improvements will consist of milling and overlaying the following streets inside the gated area: Sargasso Sea, Carrizales, Turner, Park Road 100, Marina Lab Drive, and Channel View Loop. The following streets are located outside the gated area west of the Dirty Al's Restaurant: Caspian Sea, Red Sea, Kara Sea, Marine Drive, Black Sea, Saltan Sean, and Beaufort Sea. These improvements will enhance the safety and accessibility of the visitors at Isla Blanca Park and are part of the Cameron County Coastal Parks Master Plan.

Since the adoption of the Cameron County Coastal Parks Master Plan, the Commissioners' Court has completed approximately \$35 million in Coastal Park improvements at Isla Blanca Park and E.K. Atwood Park (Beach Access No.5). Improvements to the Isla Blanca County Park include The Amphitheater & Event Center, two new beachfront pavilions (DJ Lerma & Sandpiper), a beachfront boardwalk, restroom renovations at the Jetties, R.V. Park restroom/bathhouse renovations, sidewalks, new parking areas, and the recent announcement of the construction of a new Parks Administration Building. E.K. Atwood Park improvements include five new pavilions, community rinse stations, dune walkovers, restrooms, and permeable parking.

Street improvements are scheduled to begin on April 25, 2022, and end on or before May 26, 2022, weather permitting. During the time of construction, patrons can expect to encounter temporary traffic delays while entering or exiting the Park and accessing the RV sites. We thank all park visitors for your patience and understanding and ask to please be mindful of all traffic control equipment and heed all warning signage. A construction schedule for each street improvement will be posted on the Cameron County Parks and Recreation Facebook Page and Website at <https://www.cameroncountytexas.gov/parks-home/> for your convenience.

The engineering, design, and oversight of the street improvements are by the Cameron County Department of Transportation. Construction will be through the Cameron County Public Works Department.
