**STREET IMPROVEMENTS AT ISLA BLANCA PARK ARE COMPLETE
AHEAD OF MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND**

Cameron County is pleased to announce that the road improvements to twelve streets at Isla Blanca County Park in South Padre Island, TX, are complete. The following County roads were milled, overlaid and improved: Sargasso Sea, Carrizales, Turner, Park Road 100, Channel View Loop, Caspian Sea, Red Sea, Kara Sea, Marina Drive, Black Sea, Saltan Sean, and Beaufort Sea. Road improvements on Marine Lab Drive will be rescheduled for early October of 2022.

These road improvements are part of the Cameron County Coastal Master Plan, of which since adoption in 2016, \$35 million in Coastal Park improvements have been completed. Cameron County Parks & Recreation welcomes visitors year-round to its nine (9) Community Parks, five (5) Coastal Parks, four (4) Public Beach Access Areas, and two (2) Social Service Centers.
