In addition, Cameron County has received 0 self-report of at-home testing.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of three (3) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. Of these deaths, one was fully vaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 2,237.
