UPDATE: IN-PERSON SERVICE AT LEVEE BUILDING RESUME

In-person service at the Cameron County Levee Building such as: Tax Assessor-Collector, County Clerk, Information Technology, and Justices of the Peace 2-1, 2-2, 2-3, and Constable Precinct 2 have resumed operations.

On November 22, 2022, a transformer outage, caused by moisture entering the main electrical distribution panel, resulted in a disruption of power causing in-person services and county applications including internet and email to be temporarily inaccessible. Emergency purchase orders were issued to assess the damages, and working through the Thanksgiving Holiday, the damaged electrical equipment was removed and power was temporary restored through the use of back-up generators. New electrical distribution panels to replace the damaged equipment have been ordered, and the permanent electrical service to the building should be restored by December 19, 2022.

On November 23, 2022, Cameron County Department communication such as email, internet, phone, county software and programs were fully restored, with the exception at the Levee Building.

Operations have resumed at the Levee Building, and all residents are encouraged to contact the respective department for updates, information, and hours of operation and availability, before arrival:
