Cameron County Public Health has received notification of one (1) additional COVID-19 related death of a Cameron County resident. The reported death was not fully vaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 2,314.

Cameron County continues the vaccination efforts within our communities. As of today, 84.38% of the population 6 months and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 99.99% has received at least one dose. In addition, 95.12% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 99.99% has received at least one dose.
