AMENDED INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF CAMERON AND THE CITY OF LAFERIA

THIS AMENDED AGREEMENT is for Contract No. 2021C09310 and is entered into between the CAMERON COUNTY, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and the CITY OF LA FERIA, hereinafter referred to as "LA FERIA", on this _____ day of ______, 2022, pursuant to the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act and under the authority of Section 251.012 of the Texas Transportation Code.

WHEREAS, Cameron County is a county in the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, the City of La Feria is a town located in Cameron County, Texas;

WHEREAS, La Feria is in need of paving and drainage repairs:

WHEREAS, the County has the equipment and personnel to assist in the rehabilitation of their infrastructure;

WHEREAS, County and La Feria are authorized to enter into this Agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code 791.001 et seq.;

- 1. LOCATION OF PROJECT: La Feria, Texas Scott Sloane Memorial Park and Veterans Memorial Park Sport Complex
- 2. WORK AND SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED: The COUNTY will provide the labor and equipment for the projects shown in the Scope of Work, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.
- 3. The CITY will pay the COUNTY for costs of materials needed to complete the projects currently estimated to be \$117,832.71. The Cost Estimate is based on current COUNTY Roadway Material Unit Bid Pricing (subject to escalation surcharge) and is attached hereto as Exhibit B. This amount will be paid within thirty (30) days from the date of execution of this Interlocal Agreement. Should additional materials or cost overruns be necessary to complete the projects, the CITY will pay the costs for additional materials.
- 4. This Agreement constitutes a one-time agreement between the parties and does not constitute a continuing agreement or responsibility for maintenance by the County. Any future maintenance shall be the responsibility of the CITY.
- 5. The execution and performance of this Agreement by the County and the CITY have been duly authorized by all necessary laws, resolutions or corporate action, and this Agreement constitutes the valid and enforceable obligations of the County and the CITY in accordance with its terms.
- 6. Each party agrees to conform to its own applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures with respect to the performance of the work and services under this Agreement. The Agreement shall have no legal force or effect until such time as it is properly adopted and approved by the CAMERON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT and the BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF FERIA. This Agreement shall terminate on completion of the project.
- 7. All expenditures made under this agreement will be made from the current revenues of the paying party and under the authority of Texas Transportation code 251.012

THIS AGREEMENT SHALL HAVE NO LEGAL FORCE OR EFFECT UNTIL SUCH TIME AS IT IS PROPERLY ADOPTED AND APPROVED BY THE CAMERON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA FERIA.
