

**STANDING ORDER DIRECTING THE CAMERON COUNTY DISTRICT CLERK
TO RESUME THE DATA MERGE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
TECH SHARE INDIGENT DEFENSE PORTAL
AND AUTHORIZING INDIGENT DEFENSE ATTORNEYS TO FILE EXPENSE
CLAIM FORMS THROUGH THE TECH SHARE INDIGENT DEFENSE PORTAL**

The Cameron County Board of Judges finds that there is a need for a standing order directing the Cameron County District Clerk to resume the data merge for the implementation of the Tech Share Indigent Defense Portal. The Cameron County Board of Judges also finds that, as per the Office of Court Administration, attorney expense claims are not required to be filed with the District Clerk.

IT IS ORDERED that effective May 1, 2024, the Cameron County District Clerk shall allow the Cameron County Information and Technology Department to resume the data merge on all District Court cases for the implementation of the Tech Share Indigent Defense Software. The merge is not to include any juvenile or sealed cases.

IT IS ORDERED that effective June 1, 2024, Cameron County Indigent Defense Attorneys will file expense claim forms through the Tech Share Indigent Defense Portal.
