RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED THAT ON THIS THE 6TH DAY OF April 2025, THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF CAMERON COUNTY, TEXAS CONVENED IN REGULAR SESSION AND THE FOLLOWING ITEM WAS PLACED ON THE AGENDA OF SAID COURT FOR SUCH MEETING, PURSUANT TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 511.041 et seq., VERNON'S TEXAS CIVIL STATUTES (THE TEXAS OPEN MEETING ACT) TO BE CONSIDERED:

"CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF APRIL 2025 AS FAIR HOUSING MONTH, AND ADOPT AND RE-AFFIRM THE FAIR HOUSING POLICY IN CAMERON COUNTY".

WHEREAS, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, prohibits discrimination in housing and declares it a national policy to provide, within constitutional limits, fair housing in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the principal of fair housing is not only natural law and national policy but a fundamental human concept and entitlement for all Americans;

WHEREAS, the anniversary of the National Fair Housing Law, during the month of April, provides an opportunity for all Americans to recognize that complete success in the goal of equal housing opportunity can only be accomplished with the help and cooperation of all Americans;


WHEREAS, Cameron County is a grant recipient of U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grants, consisting of the Texas Community Development Block Grant active contracts from Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) and Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA):


WHEREAS, HUD requires TxCDBG grantees, like Cameron County, to proclaim April as "Fair Housing Month" and adopt and Re-Affirm the Fair Housing Policy as a Fair Housing activity during the TxCDBG contract period;
NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED:


1. THAT the Cameron County Commissioners Court hereby proclaims the month of April 2025 as FAIR HOUSING MONTH in the County of Cameron, and adopt and re-affirms the Fair Housing Policy and does hereby urge all the citizens of this locality to become aware of and support the National Fair Housing Law.
2. THAT this Resolution be published in a newspaper of general circulation to inform the public of National Fair Housing Law.


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Cameron County- Fair Housing Policy
